Organizations in Guatemala that support the Association:

AJPU (a word from K'iche, an indigenous language of Guatemala, that means “leader”) – construction and installation of filters, latrines, and stoves

APROFAM (Association for the Well-Being of the Family) – training of community health workers

CEDEPCA (Protestant Center for Pastoral Studies in Central America) – training for resilience in disasters, legal rights of women, and family gardens; facilitates intercultural encounter trips for youth and adults traveling from US to visit partners in Guatemala

Heifer International Consultants – training in (1) vaccinating animals; (2) making organic fertilizer; (3) constructing shelters that better protect animals and channel their waste for use as fertilizer; and (4) growing family gardens
